For Theater Attire and Performance.

Wear your class leotard for rehearsals Sunday-Wednesday.

Pink or flesh tone ballet tights should be worn all week.

Nude leotards are allowed under costumes for students needing extra coverage.

Ballet shoes. Please make sure these are in tip-top shape and your students do their best to keep their ribbons tucked in.

Come with your hair already done (or have a parent volunteer/teacher help you)

Items needed to make a ballet bun:

- Bobby Pins (preferably the same color as the student's hair)
- Hair Ties (preferably the same color as the student's hair)
- Hair net (preferably the same color as the student's hair, color options are black, brown, or blond for ballet hair nets). Ballet hair nets are very thin and delicate, they will barely show when wrapped around the student's ballet bun.
- Brush/Comb
- Gel, Water in a Spray bottle, and Hair Spray

All items can be found at Target, Walmart or Walgreens.

IMPORTANT: On the days of each of the shows, students are required to be at the Theater **1 hour** prior to show time. During this time, parent volunteers and teachers are here to help. Please bring the above items with your child so that we can assist or do your child's hair during this classroom time.

Note on Make-up: - We've got you covered!

Make up is provided in each room for performers to be applied by parent volunteers and teachers. If you want to send your own – this is what we have planned for each level:

Level Pre Ballet- 1B

- -Red Lip stick (applied with one q-tip per student)
- Blush along the cheekbone

Level 2A/2B

- -Red lip stick (applied with one q-tip per student)
- -Blush along the cheekbone
- -Eye makeup (brown shadow along the brow bone) applied by choreographers (use only disposable applicators).

Miscellaneous

Beginning on Thursday-Sunday, please drop off and pick up your child from their classroom. You will have 10 minutes to settle your child before we ask our parent volunteers to take over care. Please pick up your child within 10 minutes of their release at the end of the day. After that time, your contact information will be utilized to check in.
